MHBA elects five to board of directors

Successful candidates in this year's election for the Maryland Horse Breeders Association's board of directors were William K. Boniface, Amy Hopkins Daney, Redmond C.S. Finney, King T. Leatherbury and Glenn R. Martin.

Of the five, only Daney is a first-time director.

Boniface served on the board from 1988 to 1990 and 1993 to 1998. Leatherbury, who was president of the organization from 1988 to 1991, has had four previous terms as a director (1985 to 1990; 1992 to 1997). Finney and Martin were reelected as incumbents.

The board is comprised of 15 members, and each year five directors are elected to three-year terms. Directors are ineligible to stand for reelection after serving two consecutive three-year terms.

Directors whose terms did not expire in 2002 are Richard F. Blue Jr., Thomas R. Bowman, Ronald S. Green, David Hayden, Donald P. Litz Jr.,

Robert T. Manfuso, E. Allen Murray Jr., Michael Pons, James B. Steele Jr. and Frank P. Wright.

Judith Z. DiNatale and Ann Merryman were ineligible to stand for reelection because of having served six consecutive years as a member of the MHBA board.

Following are brief profiles of this year's electees:

- Boniface, 38, manages the breeding division of his family's Bonita Farm in Darlington. He is also a director of Maryland Million Ltd. and Fasig-Tipton Midlantic and serves as chairman of the Maryland Million nominations committee.

- Daney, 37, manages family-owned Elberton Hill Farm in Darlington. Daney serves

on the MHBA's yearling show committee.

- Finney, 72, is co-owner with his wife Jean of Landslide Farm in Upperco. He is retired from a long career as headmaster of Gilman School in Baltimore. Finney also serves on the MHBA yearling show committee.

- Leatherbury, 69, a long-time leading Maryland train-

er, is the owner with his wife Linda of Craftwell Farm in Shadyside. Leatherbury currently is president of Maryland Million Ltd.

- Martin, 60, is co-owner with her husband J.W.Y. Martin Jr. of Worthington Farms in Glyndon. She also is a director of Fasig-Tipton Midlantic. ♣

Rain gets job done at Potomac

NASCAR cars and drivers are plastered with sales messages and logos—but that's because there's something to sell. That would never work in horse racing. Unless of course the horses are for sale.

Trainer Jack Fisher put his timber horse Rain in the classified section of the May 17 *Steeplechase Times*, but took the sales pitch another step when Rain lined up for a race at the Potomac point-to-point on May 19 in Seneca.

Moments before the \$7,500 Preakness timber race, Fisher took the number cloth from jockey Roger Horgan and added a "For Sale—Cheap" line to the Number 9.

Rain and jockey Roger Horgan did their part, galloping to a win over Stage Radiance in the three and a quarter-mile race. Racing just off the early pace, Rain rolled to the front in the final quarter-mile and scored by a length and a half. Oscar Max was third.

Owned (still) by Edie Dixon, Rain went home to the Fisher barn. Offers were still pending.

"I like Rain a lot; he'd be a great buy for someone," said Horgan. "In a lot of ways, he's just a horse, but he does his job and does everything as professionally as you could expect a horse to..."

A gray 7-year-old, Rain (a son of Miswaki and the Northern Baby mare Showers) won once over hurdles for Fisher and added an NSA timber win last fall. He doesn't fit Fisher's upscale barn, but has a steeplechase future nonetheless.

"He'd be the perfect owner/rider horse," said Horgan. "You come to a fence, he's going to get to the other side. If I had to find a fault, I'd say he's too careful, but if you want that it's a good thing."

And he's for sale.

For Horgan, Potomac was a nice end to the weekend. The jockey won the \$100,000 Joe Aitchison Stakes-NSA1 on Friday, and rode three horses at Radnor, Pa., on Saturday.

"It's one of my favorite places to go," said Horgan. "I rode at Pimlico on Friday, and there was lots of pressure. Saturday was busy, and even more work. Spending Sunday at Potomac is a treat. It's a lovely course, and I've had a lot of success there."

Potomac's \$7,500 hurdle feature went to a reformed timber horse. C and P Stable's Deadly Force was claimed last fall as a timber prospect by trainer Neil Morris but washed out and was sold to Virginia trainer Diana McClure, who put owners Reynolds Cowles

and Frank Petramalo together in the partnership.

An NSA winner over hurdles in 2000, the 7-year-old son of Dynaformer was available because of a bad habit.

"You can't hold him," McClure said simply. "He's not that bad, but he can pull. We go for long jogs cross country, and that's helped, and we've changed bits four times. Potomac was the first time we got him to settle."

Deadly Force (with McClure's husband Michael Cooney aboard) stalked Secret Initiative early and roared past while scoring by eight lengths over Salmo and Teak.

Katie and Sam Cockburn's Brance carried Grace Pariso to a narrow win over Ivory's Pleasure in the \$2,500 novice timber for trainer Bay Cockburn. The son of Diazo fought for the lead throughout, gave way to Ivory's Pleasure late but came on again to post a head victory.

Virginia trainer Mairead Carr won the \$1,000 maiden hurdle with Julia Theriot's Middleburg Life. Named after a newspaper, the horse took over in the stretch and won by five lengths over Nobooze and Master Rasper. Gerry Carwood rode the winner.

On the flat, John Pettibone's Marine (Geoff Brutscher) breezed home in the \$1,000 open flat race for trainer Dot Smithwick. Muzzleload, owned by Willie Davis, gave Pariso and the Cockburn stable its first of two wins on the day by taking the lady rider flat race in a romp over Chickachoo (Rachel Knight). ♣

Voss earns his fifth Governor's Cup training title

The final point-to-point on the Maryland Governor's Cup schedule, Potomac attracted big fields and as usual had an impact on the championship picture.

Roger Horgan nailed down the leading timber jockey and overall jockey titles thanks in part to Rain's victory at Potomac.

The other champions are:

Horse of the year: Sam Sullivan. Owned by Mimi Voss, trained by Tom Voss and ridden by Blair Waterman. The consistent gray Maryland-bred captured the Grand National Stakes, and also picked up a point-to-point win at Elkridge-Harford.

Novice timber champion: Walkin N' Memphis. Owned by Irv Naylor, trained by Sanna Neilson and ridden by Jody Petty. As the name indicates, this division is for relative newcomers and parity ruled. No horse won more than one race. Irv Naylor's Walkin N' Memphis, a recent hurdle convert, collected eight points with a win at Howard County and a third at Elkridge-Harford.

Leading trainer: Tom Voss. Title number five for the

Monkton-based trainer who also leads the National Steeplechase Association standings. Voss won races with Sam Sullivan, Wood Whistle and Ironfist. Combined those three swept the cards at My Lady's Manor and the Grand National.

Leading rider/timber rider: Roger Horgan. The Irishman won the overall crown for the third consecutive season while riding for several trainers. Horgan won the Manor with Ironfist and collected wins at Potomac and Elkridge-Harford during a busy spring season.

Leading ARCA rider: Blair Waterman. In her first full season in Maryland, Waterman won two races with Wood Whistle and one with Sam Sullivan. Like Horgan, Waterman works for the Voss stable.

Hunter Chase Timber Champion: This division wound up a four-way tie among Costly Fun, Ivorgorian, Just Plain Texas and Right About Now.

Leading junior rider: Rosi Napravnik. Rode French Revolution to wins at Elkridge-Harford and Howard County

Leading pony rider: Jessica Rice. Spread herself around and picked up small pony victories at Potomac and Marlborough with Summer and won a large pony race with Lieutenant Bodgit at Marlborough.

Hunt team: Green Spring Valley extended its streak to three in the foxhunter relay division and won a tight race with Marlborough.

Northern Sting: 1980-2002

Richard Granville's Northern Sting, one of Maryland's broodmare gems, died following a bout with colic on May 23. The 22-year-old mare, who resided at the Boniface family's Bonita Farm in Darlington, was in foal to first-year Bonita stallion Mojave Moon. She produced her last foal in 2000, a Lear Fan colt owned by Granville named Sting Lear, who is currently in training.

Northern Sting was named Maryland's broodmare of the year twice, in 1995 and 1997. The first eight of her ten foals are winners, and she produced three stakes winners in succession. Her first stakes winner, Icy Warning, was born in 1990 as her fourth foal.

Icy Warning, a daughter of Caveat, made 51 starts during five seasons, won or placed 29 times, and earned \$516,202. The roan mare's added-money victories came in the River Downs Breeders' Cup Handicap and Hollywood Park's Variety Queen Stakes. Her 11 stakes placings included four in graded company.

Northern Sting's 1991 foal died; she then was returned to Caveat and produced Ops Smile in 1992.

Ops Smile was a stakes winner each season from 3 to 6, and amassed \$785,246 with nine victories (six stakes), eight seconds (three stakes) and five thirds (three stakes) from 42 starts. His most eye-catching win came in the Grade 1 Manhattan Handicap, in which he completed the mile and a quarter over Belmont Park's turf course in 1:59 while defeating Flag Down. Ops Smile's additional graded stakes scores were in the Dixie Stakes-G2 and Longfellow Handicap-G3.

Northern Sting was bred to Preakness Stakes-G1 winner Deputed Testamony in 1992, and the result was Testing.

Winner of the 2000 Maryland Million Classic, Testing earned \$528,245 during six seasons. He won or placed in 27 of his 46 starts and also counted the Congressional Handicap among his 11 victories.

Northern Sting has one additional stakes runner to her

credit—Caveat's daughter Northern Flair, who was second in the Pearl Necklace Stakes and third in the Maryland Million Ladies Stakes, earning \$108,185. Owned by Granville, the now-7-year-old Northern Flair produced her first foal in April, a colt by Lear Fan, and was bred back to Mojave Moon.

Granville privately purchased Northern Sting from Jim Ryan, of Ryehill Farm fame, in the fall of 1992. Ryan had bought the mare, in foal to Shelter Half, out of the Fourbros Stable dispersal at the 1988 Fasig-Tipton Midlan-

tic December Mixed sale for \$29,000.

Bred in Maryland by Fourbros Stable (the partnership of Bob and Tom Manfuso and George and Geoffrey Hugueley), Northern Sting was also a successful stakes performer, doing her best running at 2 when she captured the Smart Angle Stakes and Tri-State Futurity. The daughter of Northern Jove—Suebee, by Rainy Lake, retired with four victories and earnings of \$78,964. She was a half-sister to stakes winners St. Chrisbee (by Christopher R.) and Rain Shelter (by Shelter Half).
