Breeders and horsemen raise record PAC funds

The Maryland Horse Breeders Association (MHBA) and Maryland Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association (MTHA) joined forces this summer to conduct the most successful political fundraising effort in Maryland Thoroughbred breeding and racing history.

Well over 1,000 tickets were sold to the joint Political Action Committee (PAC) Fundraiser, the Summertime Shindig (at the Big T), held July 29 at Timonium Fairgrounds. Approximately 800 people attended the event, which featured a barbecue dinner, wheels of fortune and a silent auction.

"With cooperation and hard work on all sides, the breeders and horsemen more than doubled the results that either organization might have accomplished by itself," said PAC fundraiser chairman Frank Wright. "Our goal is to support the election efforts of state elected officials who will act favorably toward our industry, and the fundraising campaign definitely is allowing that to happen."

Joe Bertazon Jr., a masonry contractor who lives in Sparks, Md., is still receiving dividends from a \$900 investment he made 13 years ago at the Timonium sales pavilion.

For that relatively modest price, Bertazon purchased Overdue Ghost (Silver Ghost—Overdue, by Turn to Reason) at a yearling auction conducted by the now-defunct Equivest sales agency.

Overdue Ghost—the first of two stakes winners Bertazon has owned during his two decades in the horse busi-

ness—won the Betsy Ross Stakes and finished second in the Politely Stakes, earning \$96,510. Now she is a stakes producer as well, her 4-year-old son Ghostly Numbers (by Polish Numbers) having displayed spookish speed in the Mister Diz Stakes on August 18.

Ghostly Numbers campaigns in the name of Ghost Breeding, a partnership that consists of his trainer Michael Trombetta, Larry Johnson (breeder of Overdue Ghost) and Bertazon.

Seizing an early lead in the Mister Diz, a five and a half-furlong dash on the grass, Ghostly Numbers set the pace through fractions of :22.54, :45.30 and :56.76 and stopped the timer in 1:03.10, missing the course record by four-fifths of a second. Closing rapidly at the end, runner-up Access Agenda nearly nipped Ghostly Numbers at the wire, while Elberton, favored at 1.9-1, settled for third. The remaining order of finish consisted of Sylvester Questor, Dr. Max,

The White Sun, Tyaskin, Pittsburgh Kid and Burst First.

Ghostly Numbers paid \$8 as the bettors' second choice.

It was the first stakes win for Ghostly Numbers, who has won three of his last five starts since being switched to turf last April. "We thought he would improve on the grass, and he did," said Trombetta.

Overdue Ghost, who makes her home at Larry Johnson's Legacy Farm near Middleburg, Va., produced Ghostly Numbers as her second foal. She has a yearling colt by Concern, a weanling filly by Polish Numbers and is in foal for 2003 to Chief Seattle.

Think all race horses are fragile creatures, destined to fall apart under the slightest injury and compete only one or two seasons before calling it quits?

La Reine's Terms challenges that unfortunate stereotype.

A 7-year-old horse who races for his breeders Sondra and Howard Bender and has been trained throughout his career by Larry Murray, La Reine's Terms broke his neck in a pasture accident as a yearling. For a while it was tough and go whether he would live to adulthood, let alone race.

"He was insured," recalled Murray. "The veterinarian consulted with the insurance company and they gave us the go-ahead to put him down."

Rather than take that irreversible course, the Benders and Murray elected to give the youngster time.

"He got a little better every day," said Murray. "He didn't run as a 2-year-old because of his problem; we waited to break him, and even after he got started training sometimes

he'd lose control of his hind end and do a somersault on the track."

A big, powerful nearly black son of Private Terms, La Reine's Terms came to hand as a 3-year-old, however, winning two stakes, and placing in graded company. With judicious management—he races exclusively on the turf, allowing him long vacations during the winter and spring—he has won stakes in four of his five seasons of competition, and actually improved with age.

La Reine's Terms won the Find Handicap on August 11 for his second stakes victory in two outings this season. Rated behind early leaders Lightning Paces and Purple Sand, he took command in the upper stretch and drew clear to score by three and three-quarters lengths. The 122-pound highweight, La Reine's Terms gave between four and ten pounds to each of his seven rivals, while equaling Laurel Park's mile and an eighth course record with a final time of 1:46.04.

Behind La Reine's Terms, in order of finish, were Purple Sand, Pinky Pizwaanski, Cynics Beware, Dynamic Trick, Dr. Brendler, Private Slip and Lightning Paces.

The Benders bred La Reine's Terms from the King's Bishop mare La Reine Elaine, whom they purchased late in

her racing career. La Reine Elaine won the Grade 3 Gallorette Handicap and Conniver Handicap, and placed in four other added-money races, for earnings of \$174,722. Dam of two other stakes horses—Sunset Party (\$73,577, Fall H) and Racing Prince (\$54,832, 2nd William Thompson S)—La Reine Elaine died of foaling complications in 1996.

Supposedly, an unequivocally well-connected daughter of Polish Numbers, was making her stakes debut when she drove to a two and a quarter-length score as odds-on favorite against Maryland-bred rivals in the Pearl Necklace Stakes.

She left in her wake Quoit Quick, No Halos Here, Wasioto and Ace Up Her Sleeve,

while completing the mile and a sixteenth on turf in 1:42.97.

Supposedly carries the colors of Lambholm Stable, the nom de course of her trainer Roy Lerman, the longtime horseman who bred top Pennsylvania-bred money-earner and Breeders' Cup Classic-G1 winner Alphabet Soup. Lerman purchased Supposedly for \$70,000 at the 2000 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Eastern Fall Yearling sale.

Supposedly broke her maiden by a resounding eight and three-quarter lengths in her fourth start, a mile maiden

special weight on the turf at Tampa Bay Downs on April 22, and led up to the Pearl Necklace with a second and third in New York allowance company (July 7 and 24). All but the first of her eight career outings have been on the turf.

Supposedly is the final foal and fourth stakes performer from her dam Allegedly (by Sir Ivor), one of this state's most remarkable broodmares of the past few decades.

A half-sister to champion and leading sire Alleged, Allegedly (a foal of 1976) was

unraced due to a congenitally deformed right hind ankle.

H. Turney McKnight, the Monkton, Md., horseman whose mother June McKnight bred Alleged, owned the mare throughout her career, with Supposedly's co-breeders—Chestertown, Md., veterinarian Dr. Tom Bowman, his wife Chris Bowman and partner Milton Higgins—acquiring an interest in later years.

Dr. Bowman supplied the medical expertise that enabled Allegedly to complete a lengthy broodmare career that ended two years ago when she was

euthanized due to complications of old age.

Allegedly first gained fame as the dam of Per Quod (\$552,275), a 1985 gelding by Lyllos (Fr) who was a group stakes winner in Italy. Her legacy also includes graded stakes winner Suspect Terrain (\$266,863), a 1989 daughter of Corridor Key; Zilarator (1996 colt by Zilzal), who was stakes-placed in England; and the 1983 Green Dancer mare Shiitake, dam of Grade 1 winner Taking Risks. ♣

Bred by Raymond Procopio, Endless Surprise (Full Intent—Soap, by Cloudy Dawn) won the J. Edgar Hoover, Columbia and Chesapeake Handicaps and placed in five

other added-money races, earning \$330,080 during a career that spanned five seasons. He rose to prominence after being claimed for \$20,000 in the spring of his 3-year-old season by Milton L. Hillman, an Annapolis, Md., businessman who died that same year and left the horse to his heirs.

From limited opportunity at stud, Endless Surprise sired

a half-dozen winners, including Beautiful Flight (\$96,698). He stood in recent years at

Hayfields II in Baltimore County.
